

# British Columbia Salmon Restoration and Innovation Fund | Funding summary as of July 2020



## WHAT IS BCSRIF?

The British Columbia Salmon Restoration and Innovation Fund (BCSRIF) is a contribution program funded jointly by the federal and provincial governments.

The fund will provide up to **\$142.85 million over 5 years** to support protection and restoration activities for priority wild fish stocks, including salmon. BCSRIF also supports projects that will ensure the fish and seafood sector in BC is positioned for long-term environmental and economic sustainability.

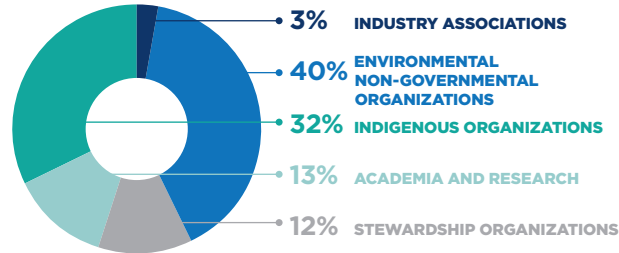

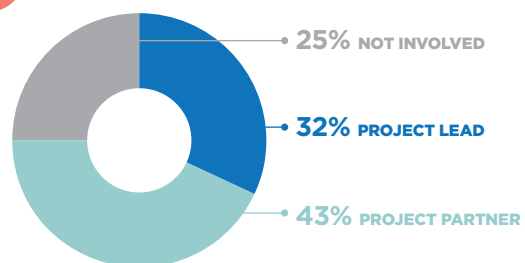

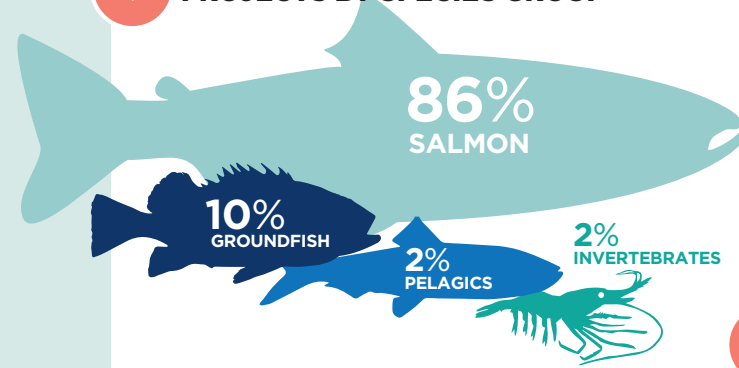

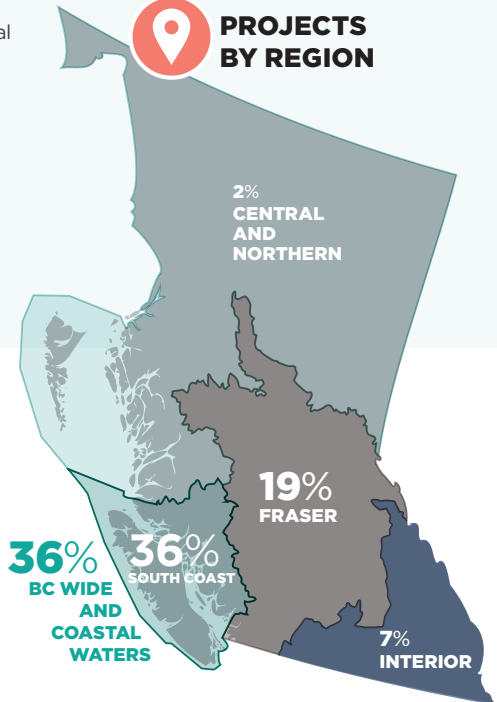
