FOREWORD

Although this summary still follows the general format originally used in 1969, the figures are now shown in metric tons (1,000 kilograms). The summary will be followed by a detailed Annual Report to be made available on written request.

Prior to 1973 net caught salmon was valued at the cash buying price or minimum prices negotiated by the United Fishermen and Allied Workers Union and the Fisheries Association of British Columbia. Since 1973 actual prices paid on the fishing grounds have been used because competition for salmon has resulted in higher than minimum negotiated prices being paid.

Monthly periods do not coincide exactly with calendar months, but are held constant at either four or five weekly periods as follows:

Four weeks - February, March, May, June, August, September and November.

Five weeks - January, April, July, October and December.

Under International agreement Canadians may land halibut at U.S. ports. Since 1964 these landings have been included in British Columbia Catch Statistics.

This report was compiled by the staff of the Statistics Division under the direction of Mrs. M. Kostner.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. All figures in this publication are reported as follows:

- Lingcod is reported as Round weight. Multiply Round weight by 0.72 to convert to Dressed head-off.

- Sablefish (Black Cod) is reported as Round weight. Multiply Round weight by 0.70 to convert to Dressed head-off.

- Pacific Cod (Grey Cod) is reported as Round weight. Multiply Round weight by 0.80 to convert to Dressed head-on.

- Halibut is reported Dressed weight head-off.

- Salmon - Troll and Handline are reported Dressed weight Head-on
- Seine and Gillnet are reported Round weight.

- All other fish are reported as Round weight.

2. Taku and Stikine catches are now excluded from the North Coast Summary.

3. "Small" Chinook are net caught fish under 5 pounds round weight.

4. Due to rounding, rows and columns may not total exactly.

5. In this publication, dates refer to date of delivery. The date of delivery is not necessarily the date of catch for trollers, gillnetters and seiners using modern fish storage methods.

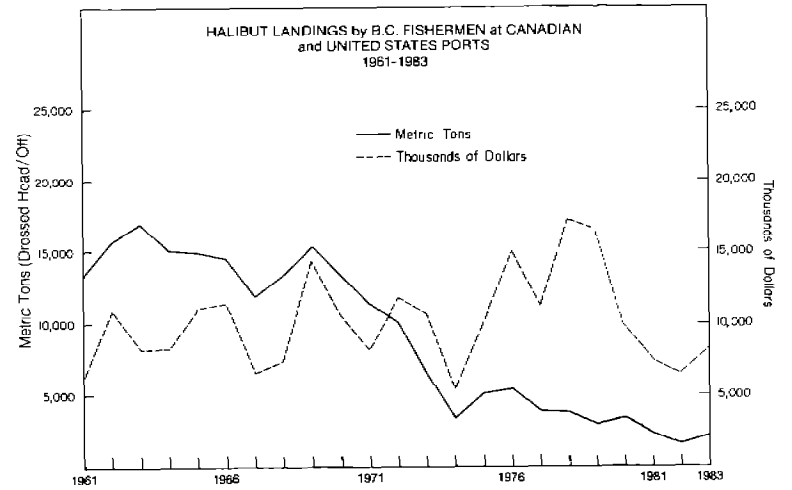
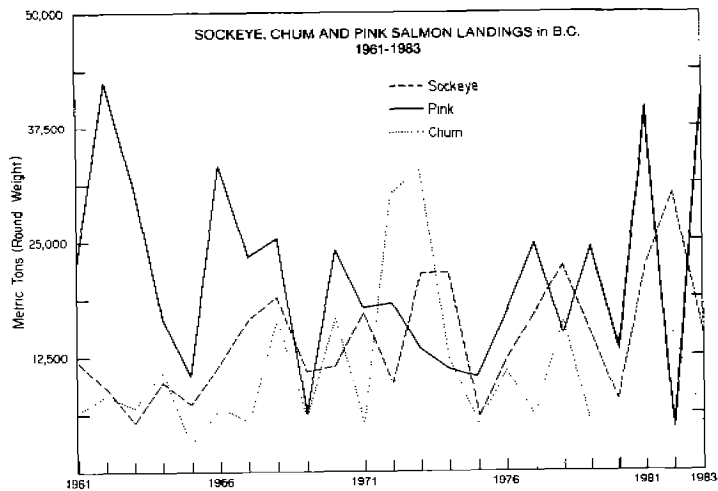
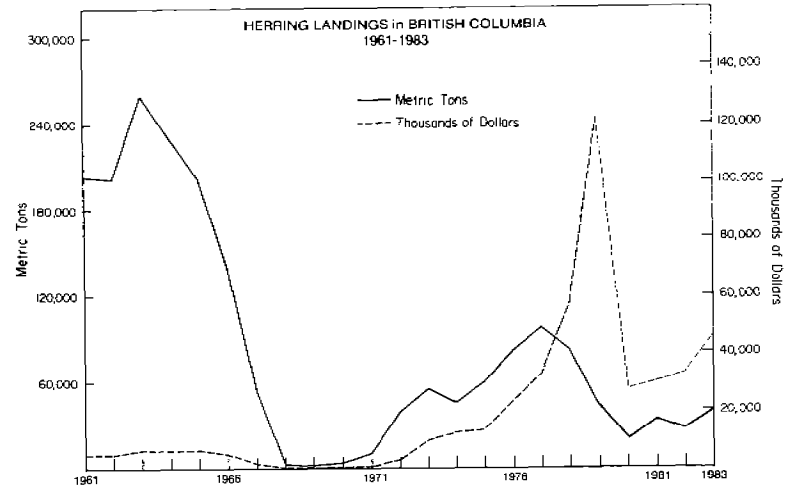
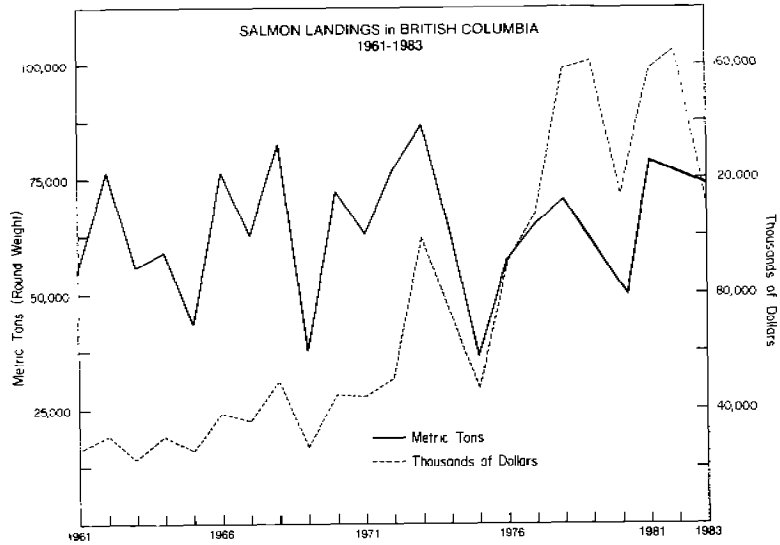

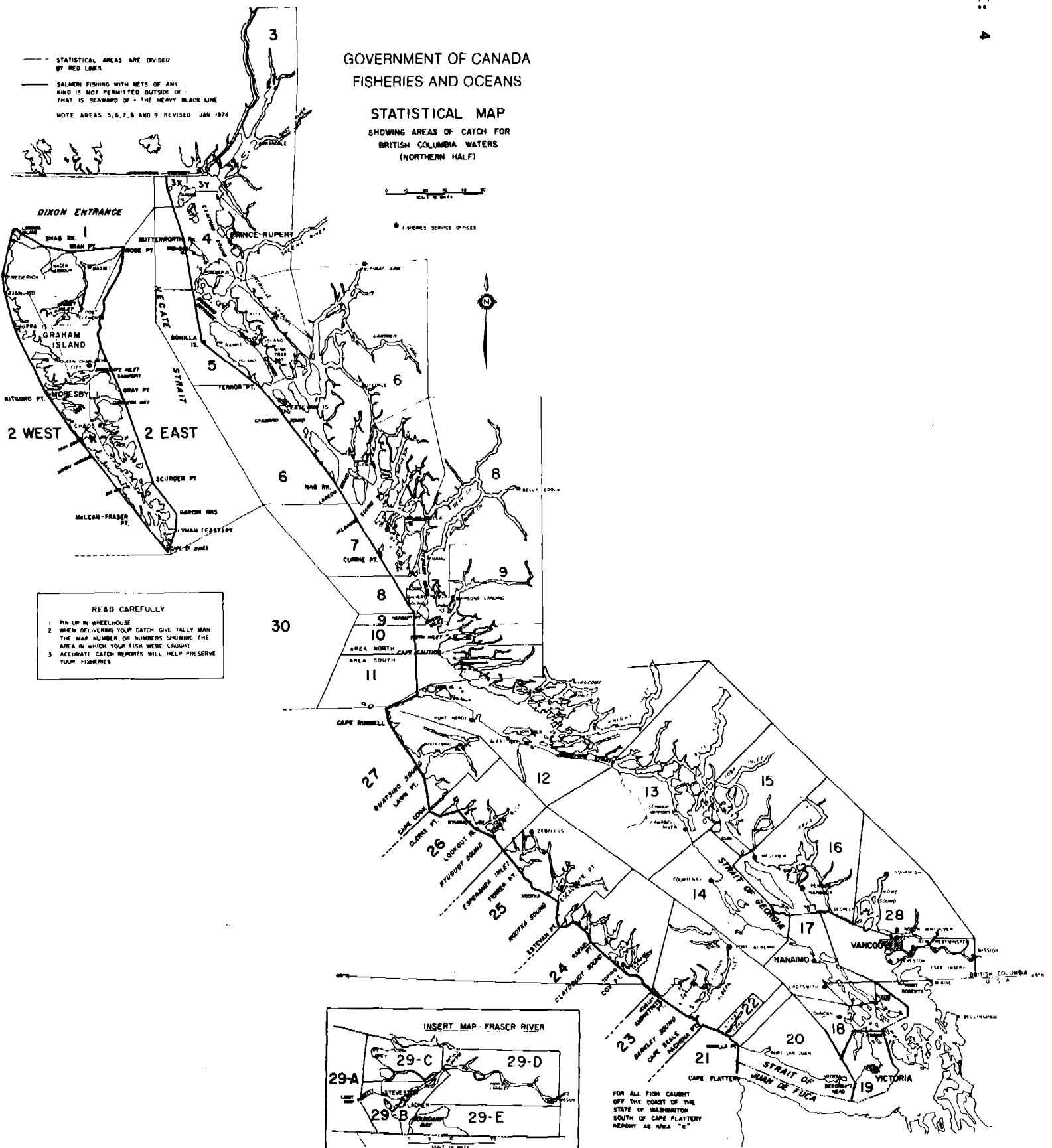
STATISTICAL MAP

(NORTHERN HALF)



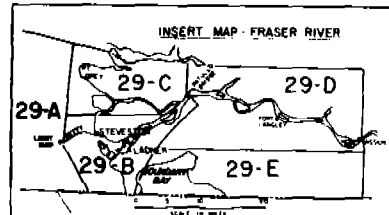

SUMMARY OF CATCH STATISTICS - BRITISH COLUMBIA - 1983

Landings by B.C. fishermen in 1983 increased by 23 469 M.T. (18%) from 1982. However, the landed value decreased by \$33.3 million (14%).

HERRING

Herring landings increased from 28 598 M.T. in 1982 to 39 820 in 1983, an increase of 39%. The value increased from \$32 million in 1982 to \$46 million in 1983, an increase of 44%.

GROUND FISH

Landings of sole, Pacific cod and lingcod decreased slightly in 1983. Sablefish landings were up by 10%.

SALMON

Despite an increase in volume of 8 955 M.T. (round weight), the value of 1983 deliveries decreased by \$54 million from 1982. Pinks account for 53% (by weight) of all salmon landed. Chinook, Sockeye and Chum showed considerable declines.

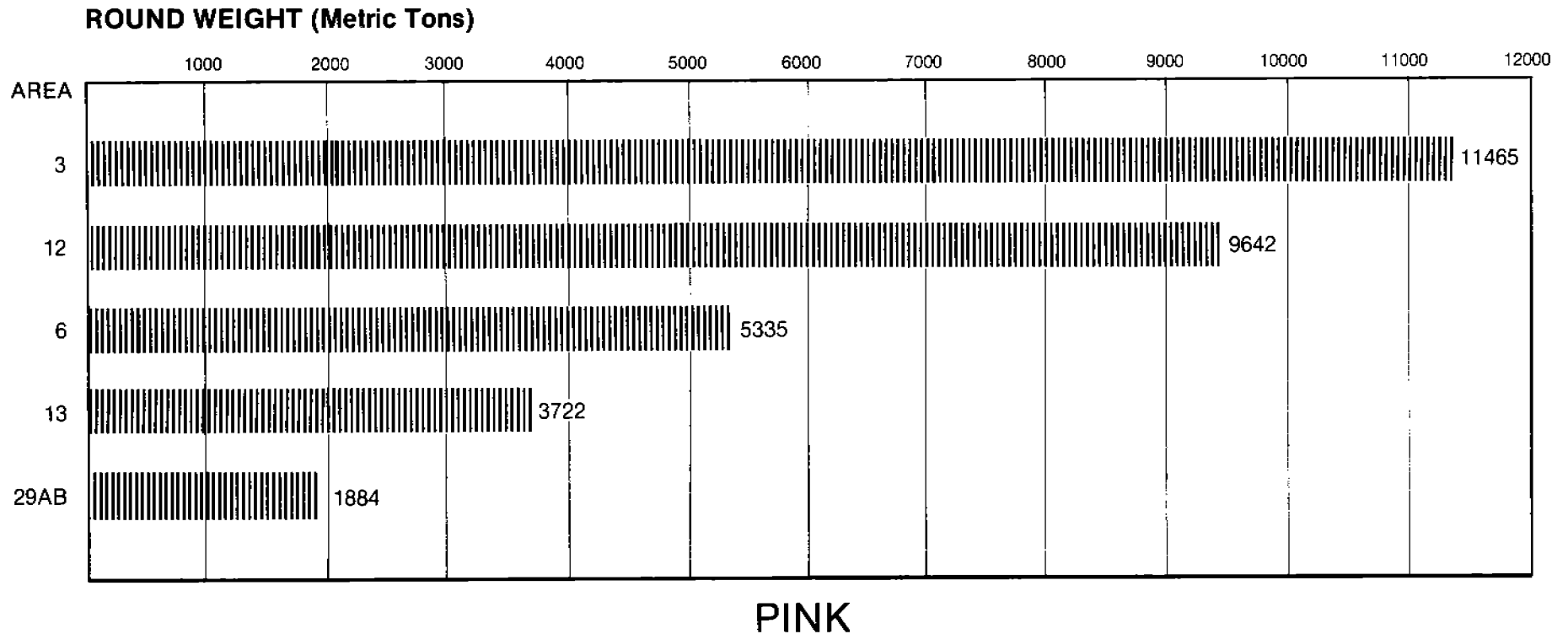

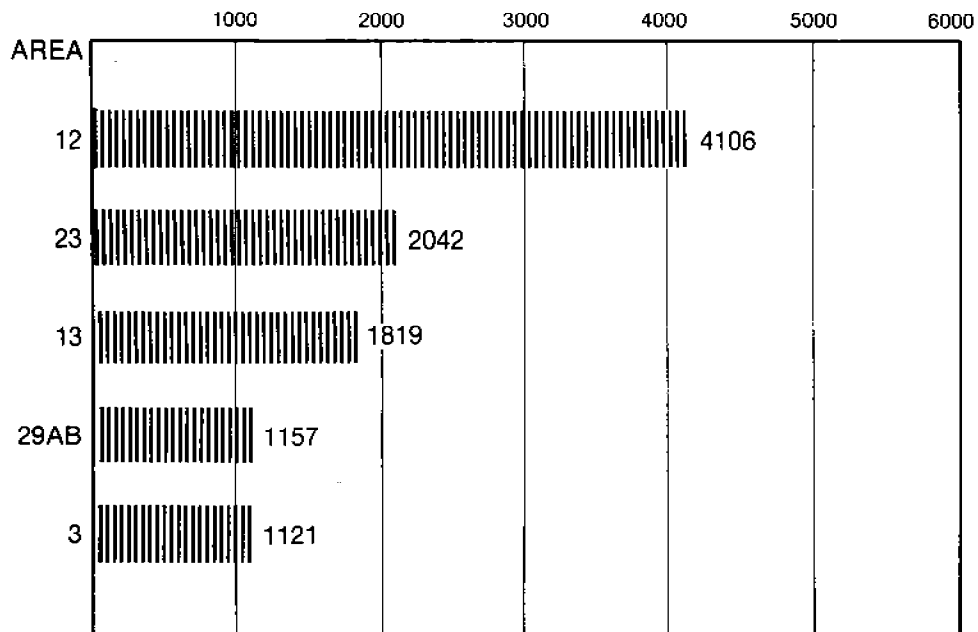

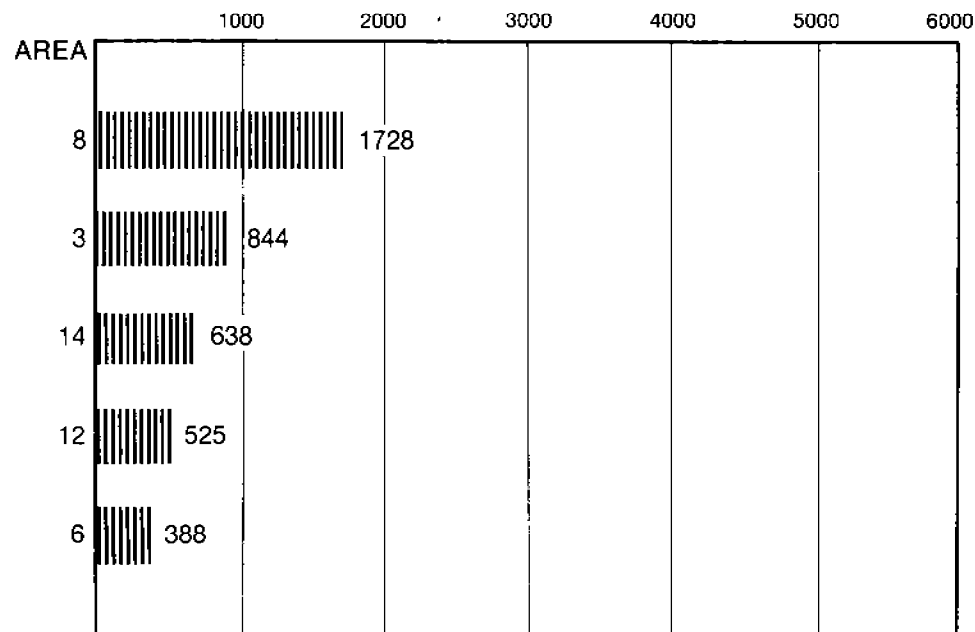

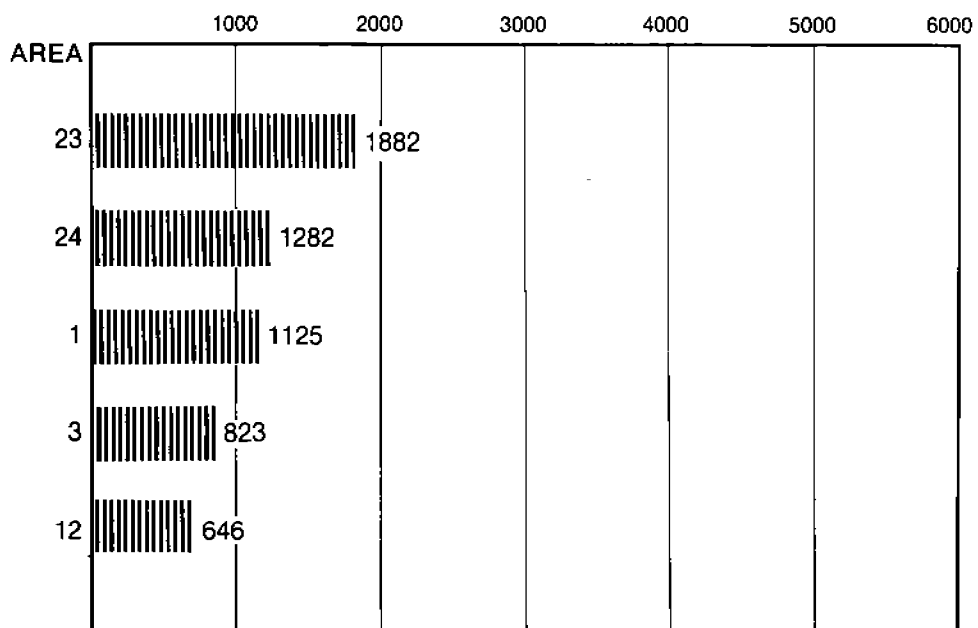

ROUND WEIGHT (Metric Tons)



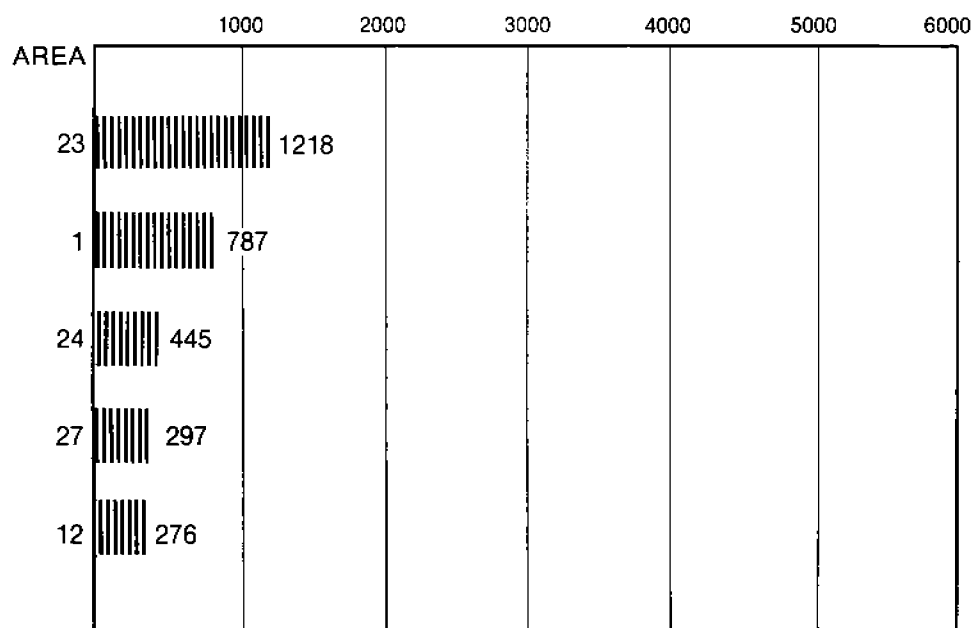

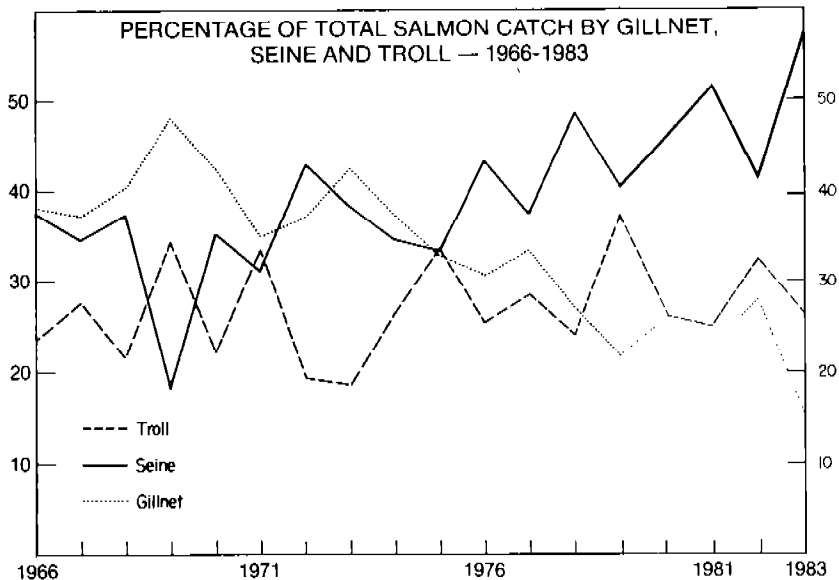
