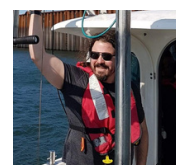
Paul Snelgrove, Champion for A Healthy and Resilient Ocean, has been reflecting on his role and vision for his thematic network:

disciplines that can support such strategies, engage partners, and apply lessons learned to identify where strategies proved successful in one application and may have potential application elsewhere. 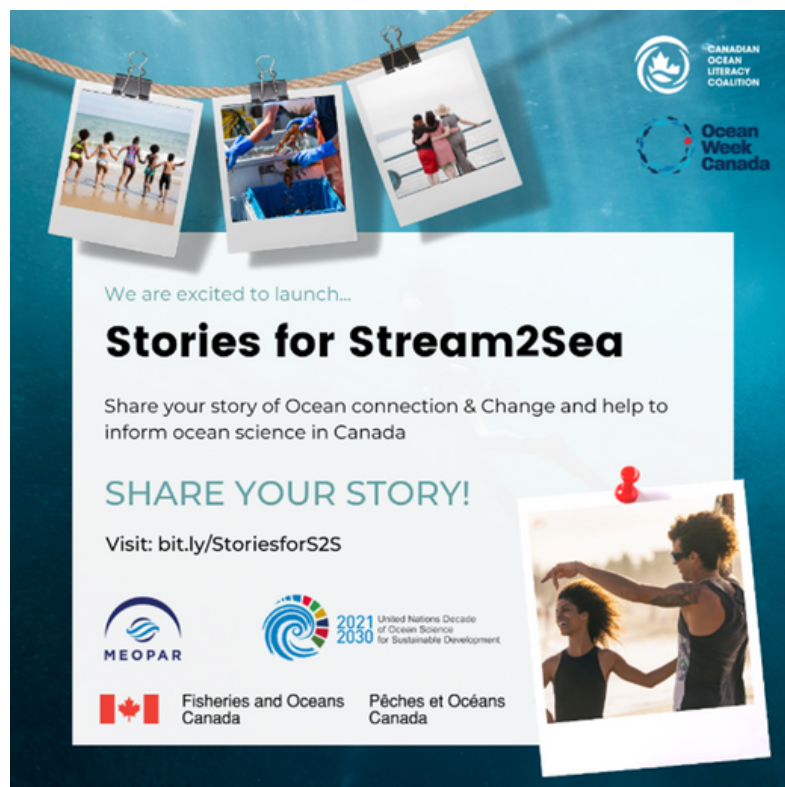

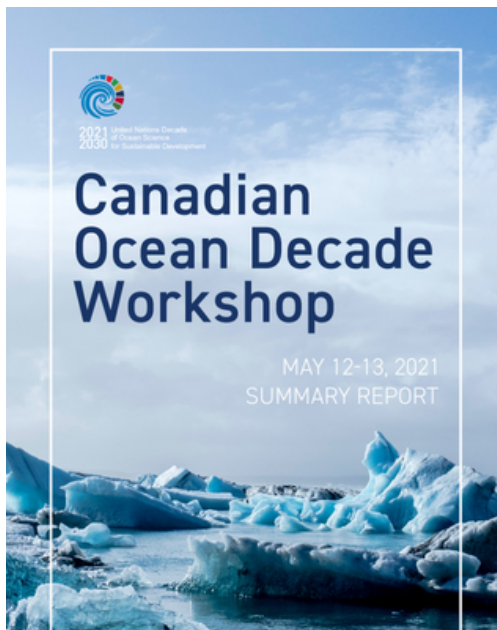



Ways To Get Involved:
