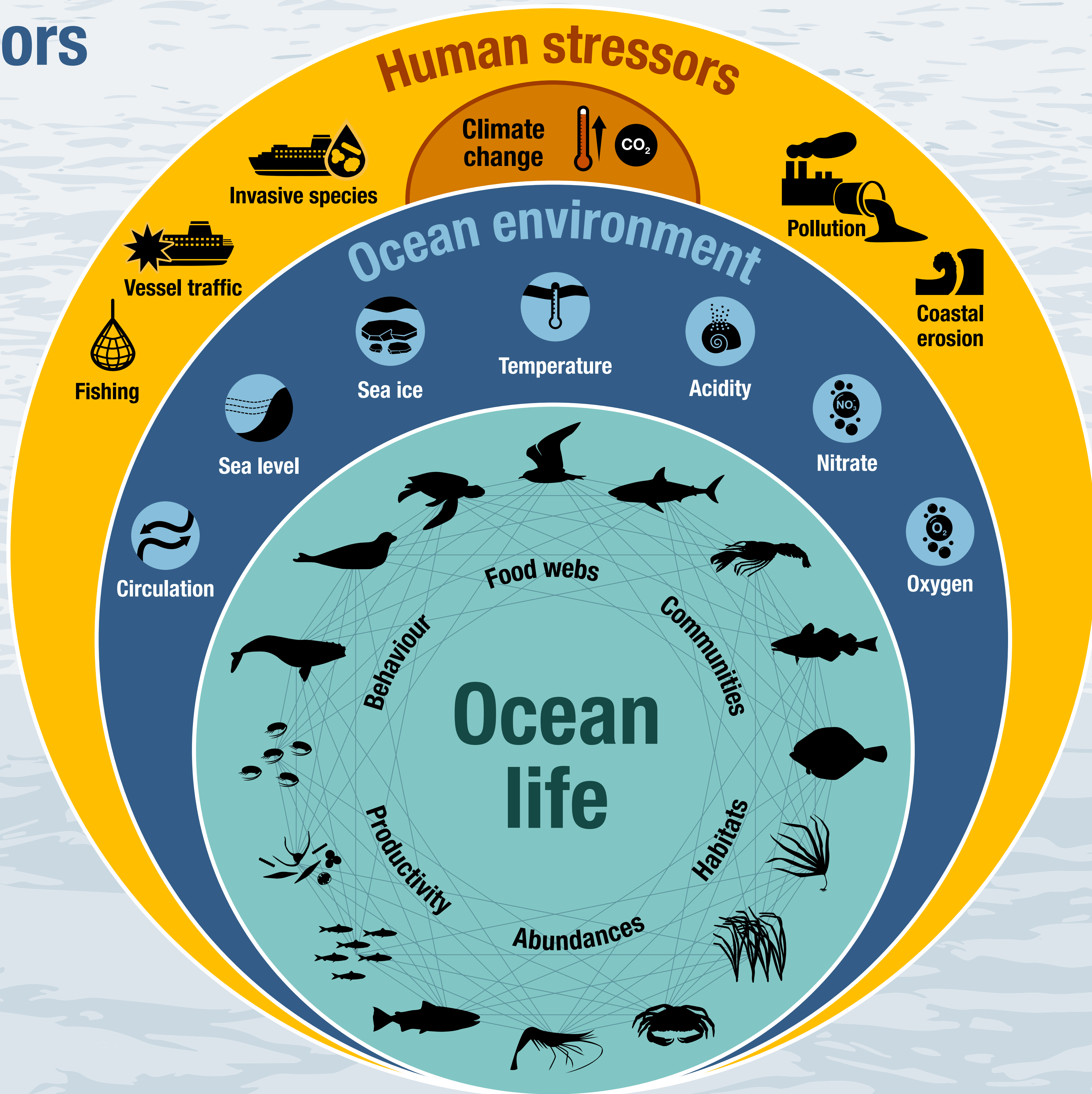


Human stressors are changing Atlantic ecosystems
