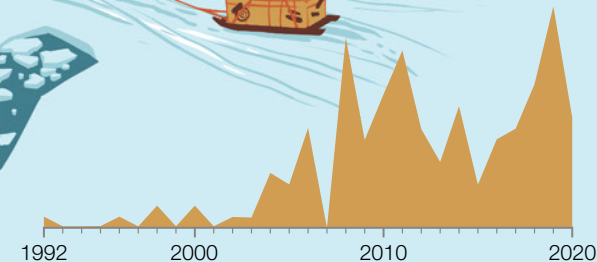


# Scientific research and Indigenous Knowledge
